I acknowledge that I voluntarily have applied to participate and use, with my dog(s), the Northern Virginia Regional Park Pool facilities (“the pool”) for the Dog Days event on September 11, 2010.

I understand that the act of unleashing my dog(s) and being physically present inside the pool area necessarily involves risks of injury to me, to other people, to my dog(s), and to other dogs. I understand these risks are entirely my responsibility. I expressly assume these risks. I am aware of the risks and hazards inherent upon entering the pool area and I choose to voluntarily enter the premises, knowing the conditions might become more hazardous and/or dangerous for myself and/or dog(s) and I voluntarily assume all such risks, loss, damages, or injury that may be sustained by entering the pool.

By signing this Assumption of Risk and using the pool, I hereby fully and forever release and discharge the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority and its volunteers, employees and agents from any claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my use or intended use of the pool.

I fully and forever release and discharge the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority and its volunteers, employees and agents from any and all negligent acts and omissions in the same. By signing this agreement I also agree to indemnify the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority and its volunteers, employees and agents from any claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, brought against any or all of such entities based on my use or intended use of the pool.

If you have any questions or concerns prior to participating in the Dog Days event, talk to the park manager of aquatic supervisor.

Rules of Participation

- At least one adult human per dog, please. Absolutely no humans allowed in the water.
- Each person must sign the Release of Liability, and the Rules, before entering.
- All dogs must have a current license and proof of rabies vaccination.
- Be courteous to other guests and clean up your dog’s “accidents.”
- Your dog may be released from their leash only upon entering the designated pool area.
- Please do not trim your dog’s nails prior to attending the Dog Swim.
- No children under the age of 16 are allowed without adult supervision.
- Your dog must remain under your control at all times. If your dog is acting aggressively, you and your dog may be escorted from the event.
- Please be sure your dog has been exposed to swimming. Some dogs swim well, some don’t. If not, he/she may become afraid or aggressive.
- Please help your dog into and out of the pool.
- Female dogs in season are not allowed.
- No dogs with health conditions that may endanger themselves or others.
- Outside food or drinks (pet or human) are not allowed in the pool area.
